

To compete internationally in FIS sanctioned events it is a requirement of SAI to ensure that all Irish athletes entered have insurance that specifically covers competitive skiing and /or snowboarding.

SAI recommends that you seek a snow sports focused travel insurance policy with the additional cover for snow sports competitions.
Athlete insurance must adhere to the following FIS rules:

All competitors participating in FIS events must carry accident insurance, in sufficient amounts to cover accident, transport and rescue costs including race risks as well as appropriate third-party liability insurance.
